Dear Parent or Carer,

As our year 11 students are approaching the Summer 2026 Exam Series (our first **whole-school** exam is on 11.5.2026) I will be writing to you weekly in order to keep you informed of key year 11 actions we are taking to support your child.

Over the last few weeks, we have consistently emphasised the importance of students engaging with activities additional to their lessons so that they can approach their summer exams with confidence for success. Here is a brief outline of what we expect students to be doing:

- maintaining a high attendance to school
- engaging with their in school/after school intervention (for those who are identified as needing it)
- attending lesson 6 which is open to all year 11 students
- revising via SPARX for Maths and Science and completing their weekly assignment, **due in at 8am every Wednesday**
- revising at home, using the recommended subject rotation and materials, available on our Liberty Academy website, under Curriculum, Supporting Learning at Home, Year 11 Home/Tutor Revision Resources.

In other news, this week, we have some key events coming up for our year 11 students:

- On **Tuesday 14/04/26** we will offer free pizza to any student who stays behind for SPARX Club in the Maths department during lesson 6.
- On **Thursday 16/04/26** students will have an Assembly in tutor time which will cover how the summer hybrid timetable will work during the exam season.

Exam seats will be published in due course. There will also be a final opportunity to raise any exam-related issues (relating to rooms and seats) by contacting me before the end of April 2026. Beyond the end of April 2026, we will not be in a position to make any further changes to exam rooms/seats. More information will follow in due course.
