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UNIFORM & JEWELLERY

SCHOOL EQUIPMENT

All academy students are expected to bring the following to school every day:

- **Academy planner**
- **Pen**
- **Yondr Pouch**
- **Bag**



Students are required to carry their belongings in a school bag. All students' coats must go into their bag, or they must be left in the uniform cupboard at their own risk.

Students will receive a planner for free on their first day in the academy but will be expected to pay for a replacement if this is lost.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Coats when inside the building.

Chewing gum.

Jewellery, other than stud earrings.

Body modification piercings.

Coloured nail varnish.

False nails - Nails should be of a short, safe length.

False eyelashes.

**Eyeliner, mascara, lipstick or any other form of make-up.
(light foundation to cover up skin blemishes will be allowed)**



MOBILE PHONES

Students are NOT allowed to use mobile phones under any circumstances whilst in the academy.

All students will be given a Yondr Pouch which they must put their phones in at the start of every day.

This will then be unlocked when leaving the academy.

These will be provided to Y7 students in September, but students will not be allowed to bring their phones during Transition Week.



YONDR POUCHES

New Year 7 to watch the Yondr presentation on their first day of Transition Week:

- Link - [School Student Yondr Presentation](#)
- Students receive their pouches at the end of the presentation.
- Fill name cards out and put them into the clear compartment on the pouch.
- Follow Yondr morning / end of day procedures whilst on Transition Week (regardless of whether they have a phone presently - this is a good opportunity to practise and follow the routines).
- Hand back to Tutors on the last day of Transition Week. Tutors to store safely in the classroom over Summer.
- On the first day back, pouches should be handed back to the students. They should lock their phones away in front of their Tutor.

FREE SCHOOL MEALS

If any of the below apply to you and you have not yet applied for Free Schools Meals, please use the link at the bottom to complete an application. You must be in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- income support
- income based jobseeker's allowance
- income related employment and support allowance (ESA – IR)
- universal credit if the household is earning less than £7,400 per year
- asylum seekers receiving support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of state pension credit
- child tax credit with an annual income of no more than £16,190 as assessed by the Inland Revenue. If also in receipt of working tax credit you will not be eligible
- working tax credit run on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for working tax credit

CONTACTING THE ACADEMY

The main port of call is always reception, who will then transfer you to the correct staff member.

Tutors will always be the first point of contact for day to day occurrences, for example: uniform, equipment, homework and other general enquiries.

Any major incidents or concerns you need to report will be directed to the House Team or Safeguarding Team by reception.

If there is an urgent need for contact, the academy may get in touch during the school day.

As staff call from within the school, numbers will usually appear as “withheld” unless they are calling from an office.
